**Marriage Certificate**

Married Sarah HOGG on 25 May 1855 in Whitby, Yorkshire, England

Thomas was 22 yrs, a Mariner, father George Mitchell ( a Blacksmith)  
Sarah was 21 yrs, father George Hogg ( a Mariner)

( Sarah's father died between 1836 & 1841, Her mother Sarah remarried a William Leng in 1844 which explains William Leng given as her fathers name on her death Certificate)

I'm more inclined to take on board the info on a marriage certificate rather than a death certificate as this is would be given by the person themselves not a 3rd party as with a death certificate.
