The documents I've sent represent a fairly 'minor' research, but it's difficult to know what people want for their own family records. Some are satisfied to link up names + dates only; or to follow only a direct line when / once they have the names of their most distant ancestors. I like to know also about the former times in which these ancestors lived, their occupations; the reason they left their countries of origin + how they made their way to Australia - + of course, their lives thereafter.

If you would like more information, please feel free to ask - I love doing this sort of work! For example, there was another family of Turnbulls here very early in our history. They came free to the country + were landowners prior to arrival on the 'Coromandel'. There is a book on

I was going to write explanation of the material sent, but that may just serve to confuse, so I'll wait 'till you've 'digested' the information + perhaps you'll have question, that need answered that are relative to your needs for your family tree -

Though perhaps some information about Thomas Carter Reynolds would be OK -

William + Susan Reynolds [née Carter] came to Australia from Cornwall on the ship "Elizabeth" in 1849 with their 5 children - with another born on the ship. William was a Mason [worker in stone] and a plasterer. In Australia, he built a magnificent house for a landowner which is now a National Trust Home.

I am related through the eldest daughter Eliza, sister Thomas Carter Reynolds. She was my Great Grandmother. The name 'Carter' was the middle name for the boys of the family, & I think that the girls also used it - though they were perhaps not christened with it to begin with.

The name - Thomas Carter Reynolds - has continued down the line. The present day TCR is a Lawyer - later Barrister. His father [now retired] was a member of Parliament in successive governments during 1970's + 80's.

Curious to say, I had known Tom for years, even worked for his campaigns, but never knew we were related.

In 1983, the fires, known as Ash Wednesday fires, destroyed the town in which I lived. Our family became much involved in the rehabilitation of the area + Tom, being our local Government representative, was a constant source of support + information. No wonder we worked so well together - we shared the same genes!

But I have 'rattled on' - + you will want to ~~to~~ read your information.

It's a fascinating story, Brian - + there is a Canadian connection too which you will be able to explore.

I too have a family connection with Canada through my Grandfather Robert Hansen, who was a Canadian citizen for 55 years. A very 'secretive' character - my father told me he was a spy - but that's another story!!
