James Pettigrew Turnbull was a resident of Winthrop, Suffolk, Massachusetts when he died. He took ill while on a business trip to New York and died after a few days. He was a volunteer in the civil war as a member of company B 1st regiment and served for four years. After the war he was in shoe sales for four years. He was then appointed by President Harrison to the American consul of Mexico. He traveled extensively during his life.
